

**COULD YOU BE ELIGIBLE FOR FINANCIAL SUPPORT?**

Here at HNC we offer a range of financial support which can assist you with the costs of coming to College, including for bus passes and meals. If your annual household income is below £25,000 per year, it is likely you will be eligible for some support. Bursary groups are linked to the level of household income, with the level of support relative to this.

Bursary applications for the current academic year close this **Friday 13 October**. You can apply online via the College website, and if you need any help with this or have any questions, simply visit the Student Helpdesk in the LRC. This is here to help you, and all students are strongly encouraged to check their eligibility.

*A reminder about parking locally*

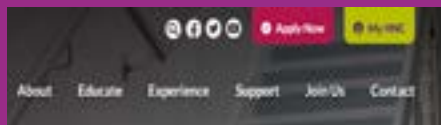
