CYBER SAVVY TOP TIP

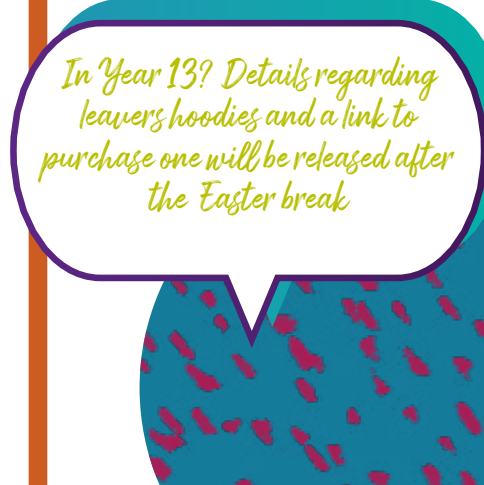
Use two factor authentication (MFA/2FA)

To keep your account data safe you should use two factor authentication where available, especially where purchases take place and payment details are stored e.g. Amazon, PayPal or Ebay accounts. Two factor authentication (2FA) (or multi factor authentication (MFA) as it's also known as) is where you receive a text message, a one-time code (using an authenticator app), use a finger-print reader or facial recognition in addition to a password to access your account.
