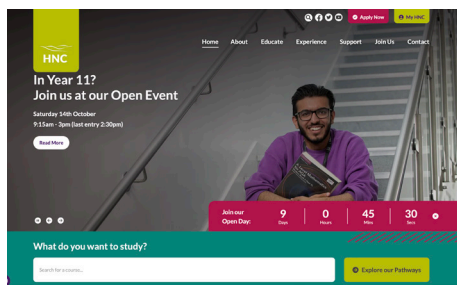


NEW HNC WEBSITE & REPORTING ABSENCE

When you visit the HNC website www.huddnewcoll.ac.uk you will notice that we have a brand new look to our website! Whilst it may look different, you can still access all the same information here including the 'My HNC' portal, which provides access to key College systems.

We would like to remind all students that any unavoidable absence must be reported by 9am via email to absence@huddnewcoll.ac.uk Please remember that any absences during the College day, e.g. if you become ill and still have lessons to attend, must be reported by visiting the LRC. Unavoidable planned absences are also requested via the Student Helpdesk.

We are aware that some Year 13 students still have the HNC app installed, which previously could be used to report absence. Due to the new website, this will shortly fully deactivate. Therefore, we'd like to provide a reminder that the only way to report your absence is via the absence email address. Please remember we cannot accept any absence notifications sent via the HNC app.
