Be greener and save money: water stations

Did you know that you can access cooled, filtered water from the plumbed in water machines located around campus?

A number of students are unaware that using a refillable water bottle is simple and easy at HNC. Refilling a water bottle is easy, and kinder to both the environment and your pocket! As they are plumbed to water mains, you can be confident they won't run out of water too. These can be found in the following locations:

- The Junction, opposite the shop
- At the entrance to the Birch building
- Within the Costa Cafe
- At the bottom of the steps/ lower ground floor of the Maple building
- Outside the Sports Hall in the Aspen Building

It is estimated that 1.3bn plastic water bottles are thrown away each day - with a 2800 strong College community using a refillable water bottle can therefore help to make a difference in the fight against the plastic crisis.



If you buy three bottles of water a week at College during term time priced at 80p, you would have spent nearly £100 - so it pays to be green!
