CYBER SAVVY TOP TIP

Use 'Shared with you' in OneDrive.

Did you know you can see documents that have been shared with you in Microsoft 365 by going to the OneDrive section and choosing 'Shared' down the left-hand side. This shows a list of files shared with you and who they are from, this ensures you can avoid going through links in emails. You can use the filter along the top to only see certain file types. Remember to only open files you are expecting - check with who has shared the file if you are unsure!
